Concerts:

- Setting up and serving refreshments to musicians at dress rehearsals (Friday nights)
- Validating admission passes to dress rehearsals (Friday nights)
- Dress Rehearsal Monitor (making sure no one hangs over the railing, etc. Friday nights)
- Committee chair for Tickets (need chair & co-chair) both Saturday and Sunday
- Selling RUSH Tickets Friday afternoon of the concert weekend (we need a student at MSU SUB location)
- Ticket sales & will call at the door of concert weekends (Sat evening & Sun. afternoon)
- Ushering at concerts for both Saturdays and Sundays
- Committee chair (and co-chair) for Sunday Concessions (selling drinks/chocolates during intermission)
- Selling concessions at the concerts during intermission (ushers can do this too at intermission)
- CD Sales at concerts (when applicable) and recitals during intermission & after the concerts
- Committee chair for musicians refreshments on Saturday nights
- Bringing refreshments for musicians to have during intermission for each concert (Saturday and Sundays)
- Planning, setting up, or working post concert receptions (usually four times a year at the start & end of season)
- Providing food for post concert receptions

Support Activities:

- Provide clerical help at the BSS office (i.e. filing season ticket orders, computer data entry, updating mailing list)
- Help with mailings (about 10 people, five or six times a year)
- Distributing posters or other promotional materials around town (couple of times a year)
- Provide transportation for guest artists (pick up & drop off at airport, around town)
- Housing for out of town musicians for the concert weekend

Special Events:

- Place for a Party for musicians and volunteers once a year (a large house) two separate days
- Make phone calls for Celebrate the Players campaign (like talking to people, making calls)
- Pops concert – help decorate, facilitate the event, and clean-up after (1 time event)
- Adams Piano Recital Series (twice a year) (ticket sales at door, usher, CD sales)

Facts about the Bozeman Symphony Society Volunteer Program:

Since the founding of the orchestra in 1968, dedicated volunteers have worked to support the organization and its mission. Over 150 dedicated people currently support the programming doing a variety of tasks before during and after the concert performances. They carry out special projects, do large mailings, and support tasks for the BSS office. Ages range from teens to retirees. Some are able to give support during the week, others because of full-time work, help during weekends and nights either on a regular basis or a few times a year, but collectively they contribute hundreds of hours each concert season.
